In connection with the maintenance of your road, Transportation Services Department, Road Operations, will be repairing such items as concrete curb and gutter, repairs & new installation of concrete sidewalks, maintenance hole/catchbasin adjustments, asphalt surfaces, regrading, restoration of boulevard and final paving of the roadway.

The Contractor will maintain a minimum one lane of traffic, where construction activities take place. Flag person and /or paid duty Police officer will be provided to direct traffic during construction.

This work may include evenings and weekend specially when working around signalized intersections.

Shrubs, hedges, facades, fences, railings around outdoor patios, paintings or any other encroachment within the public road allowance, which the owner wishes to retain, may interfere with the construction and should be removed. Any of these items still remaining at the time of construction may be removed and disposed of by the City.

Owners of properties, which have sprinkler systems on the public road allowance, must notify the Transportation Services Department of the location of the systems. The City is not responsible for damages to the sprinklers. Sprinkler systems will be dug up and put aside so that the owners may make adjustments to their systems after the work has been completed.

Owners are advised that the construction of curb and gutter and/or culverts across single vehicle driveways will require closure of the entrances for two (2) to three (3) days. Properties with two (2) separate entrances will be subject to one closure at a time and repairs will be conducted accordingly. Arrangement should be made by each property owner to find alternate legal parking until such time the driveway entrances are accessible.

The City will not be held liable for any vehicular infraction or damages caused as a result of the City undertaking repairs to curb and gutter, and/or culverts, and/or sidewalks across driveway entrance.

After the construction is completed, any damaged grassed area will be repaired. The Contractor is responsible for ensuring that new sod takes root by watering at frequent intervals during the first few weeks. The City will monitor the growth of the sod to ensure that it has rooted. Once the sod has rooted, the Contractor's obligations are completed. It will then be the property owner's responsibility to ensure continued growth through normal maintenance. Please be aware that the City will not replace sod that has been neglected.

The City will make every effort to keep inconvenience to residents, businesses and property owners to a minimum and ask for your co-operation to ensure that this work is completed without delay.
